

Numbers 14:23-24

23 not one of them will ever see the land I promised on oath to their ancestors. No one who has treated me with contempt will ever see it. **24** But because my servant Caleb has a different spirit and follows me wholeheartedly, I will bring him into the land he went to, and his descendants will inherit it.

Matthew 5:5

“Blessed are the Meek, for they will inherit the earth.”

Title: “I See Dead People”

Contempt - the feeling that a person or a thing is beneath consideration, worthless, or deserving disrespect.

To treat God with contempt is to say he is beneath you, therefore you’re NOT submitted to Him.

Meek - Humility, Gentle and Mild.

To respond to God with meekness is to say you’re under him, therefore you ARE submitted to Him.

Those treating God in contempt will NOT inherit the earth but the Meek will.

When your attitude is reflective of the Beatitudes, your future will be blessed!

1. The Meek receive Gods Truth.

Not because they're better but because they're doers of the word of God.

2. Meek speak truth

Not because they're loud but because they're submitted.

3. The Meek stand for truth.

Not because they're self-righteous but because they are self-sacrificed.

Romans 12:1-3 (NIV) A Living Sacrifice

12 Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. **2** Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your

mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

3 For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but

rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you.
