Act4 the Nations is dedicated to empowering women and children, enabling them to attain a better quality of life. Our approach involves providing comprehensive training and ongoing support to leaders in various countries on five continents. We collaborate with missionaries and anti-trafficking NGOs to sustain their critical efforts.

Our Host Organization in South Africa

Impact Africa was launched in 2004, by Rich and Michelle Franzen. Their hearts burned with a passion to help ease the suffering of the African continent, where 68% of the world's HIV/AIDS population resides. Over the years, impact Africa has become a multifaceted ministry focused on communities living in squatter camps on the periphery of Johannesburg, South Africa. Since Impact Africa's conception, five areas of focus have emerged: Impact Kids Preschools, Impact Baby Rescue, Impact Mission Adventures, Impact Students, and Impact Missions Experience Program.

Partnership Responsibilities

As a collaborative partner with Impact Church, Act4 the Nations assumes certain responsibilities for the trip. We will organize and facilitate the journey, providing collaborative team training in conjunction with the existing training from Impact Church before our trip. Additionally, we will arrange ministry opportunities during our time in South Africa. All scheduling and activities will be coordinated by the Act4 team in close partnership with the leaders of Impact Church or their appointed representative.

Trip Ministry Opportunities

Throughout the week, our ministry efforts will include outreach activities in the poorest neighborhoods. We will teach in local churches, lead Bible studies, and provide encouragement to missionaries and interns also working in the region. Furthermore, we will actively participate in the baby rescue program, engage in kids' ministry, and organize a memorable day out on a safari.
